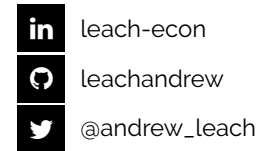
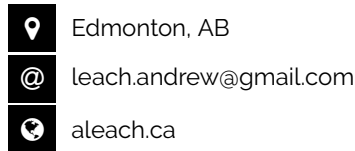


# ANDREW LEACH
